



INFORMATION ON THE NOVEL CORONAVIRUS & ENTRY TO DENMARK

Update 9 November 2020

The Royal Danish Academy of Music recommends students and staff to follow the Danish national guidelines on testing and self-isolation.

The following information is subject to change, as the measures for preventing COVID-19 from spreading and the travel restrictions may change on short notice. Therefore, it is **important that you are aware of the rules concerning your itinerary** if you intend to travel.

TESTING AND SELF-ISOLATION

It is, as from the 26th of October, necessary for **people who enter from high-risk countries to show a negative test result brought from home** before entering Denmark.

Please note the official requirements related to test certificates:

- The police only accepts **test certificates in the Scandinavian languages, German, English, French, Spanish or Italian**
- Furthermore, the **name of the tested person**, the **time of the test** and the **name of the issuer** of the certificate *must clearly appear* from the certificate.

Testing at Copenhagen Airport

It is possible to be tested for COVID-19 upon arrival at Copenhagen Airport.
